

WEST VIRGINIA HEALTH CARE AUTHORITY RURAL HEALTH SYSTEM GRANT DEADLINES

REMAINING APPLICATION CYCLE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2012

- The West Virginia Health Care Authority must receive complete Collaborative Grant Applications no later than **Monday, October 3, 2011**. The award date for these Grants, if approved will be **January 1, 2012**.
- All Collaborative Grant Applications received after **October 3, 2011** will be rejected. There will be no exception to this Application Deadline.
- Crisis Grant Applications will be considered outside the above period.
- Funding for all Grants is limited. Accordingly, the selection process is quite rigorous.
- Budgets for Crisis and Collaborative Grants or Loans are typically capped at \$50,000.00. However, the Rural Health Systems Program Management Committee would be willing to consider awarding more than this amount if an applicant were to present compelling circumstances.
- To obtain details to apply for either Crisis or Collaborative funding, please refer to the Instructions and Application sections of this site.

APPLICATION CYCLE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2013

- The West Virginia Health Care Authority will begin accepting Collaborative Grant Applications on **Wednesday, February 1, 2012** and must receive complete Collaborative Grant Applications no later than **Monday, April 2, 2012**. The award date for these Grants, if approved will be **July 1, 2012**.
- All Collaborative Grant Applications received after **April 2, 2012** will be rejected. There will be no exception to this Application Deadline.
- Crisis Grant Applications will be considered outside the above period.
- Funding for all Grants is limited. Accordingly, the selection process is quite rigorous.
- Budgets for Crisis and Collaborative Grants or Loans are typically capped at \$50,000.00. However, the Rural Health Systems Program Management Committee would be willing to consider awarding more than this amount if an applicant were to present compelling circumstances.
